



In 2019 Independent Living residents of New Bridge established a resident managed Scholarship Fund to support educational opportunities for qualified hourly independent and assisted living employees. Our desire, as stated on the logo, is to build community through education.

The Committee functions with members who review applications, mentor applicants, engage in fund raising activities and publicize those activities.

In 2020 \$54,000 was awarded to 10 recipients. In 2021, \$100,000 was raised and allocated to 17 NewBridge Scholars. The Award Ceremonies are available for viewing in our NewBridge video library.
